

## Uos Ranked At 301-350 In The Young Universities Ranking 2023

In a significant milestone, the University of Sargodha achieved a ranking of 301-350 in the Young University Rankings 2023, released by the Times Higher Education World University Rankings on July 3, 2023. The University of Sargodha (UoS) has also achieved the distinction of being the best university in Pakistan for teaching.

The Times Higher Education Young University Rankings apply the same methodology as the World University Rankings to assess research-intensive universities across all their core missions, including teaching, research, knowledge transfer, and international outlook. However, the weightings were recalibrated to align with the missions of young universities. They employ 13 carefully calibrated performance indicators to offer the most comprehensive and balanced comparisons, trusted by students, academics, university leaders, industry, and governments. The rankings encompass institutions founded between 1973 and the present.

The performance indicators are grouped into five areas: teaching (the learning environment), research (volume, income, and reputation), citations (research influence), international outlook (staff, students, and research), and industry income (knowledge transfer).

The 2023 ranking comprises of 605 universities, while 358 institutions were listed with "reporter" status, indicating that they provided data but did not meet the eligibility criteria for receiving a rank.



## UoS Ranked at 1001-1200 in THE World University Rankings for 2024

The University of Sargodha (UoS) has achieved the distinction of being ranked as the 2nd best university in Punjab for teaching and the third best in Pakistan, according to the Times Higher Education (THE) World University Rankings 2024. The University also retained its previous position 1001-1200 in THE World University Rankings for 2024.

The Times Higher Education World University Rankings 2024 include 1,904 universities across 108 countries and regions. The ranking table is based on new WUR 3.0 methodology, which includes 18 carefully calibrated performance indicators that measure an institution's performance across five areas: teaching, research environment, research quality, industry, and international outlook.

It also seeks to enhance academic collaboration, research partnerships, and the sharing of innovative ideas, expected to serve as a stepping stone towards building stronger academic bridges between Pakistan and Kazakhstan.

Dr. Serik N. Nugerbekov shared insights about the Inclusive Development Foundation of Kazakhstan, which is spearheading the Nobel Fest. The foundation, in



collaboration with COMSTECH, is planning to organize Nobel Fest in Islamabad on November 29-30, 2023. The fest aims to facilitate an independent and open dialogue on inclusive policies, focusing on vital areas such as economics, finance, technology and innovation, education, social development, and climate change. The event is expected to attract participation from OIC's 57 member countries, with their ministers of science and technology attending.




## Need To Embrace Modern Trends And Technologies
