- 5. Abusive or obscene language should not be used in the Answer Book.
- 6. Unfair Means Case will be registered against the candidate(s) who refuses to obey Center Superintendent, changes his/her Roll No / Seat with another candidate, creates disturbance, stages walkout, resorts to pen

- down strike or instigates others to do so, or otherwise misbehaves in or around the Examination Hall or having been found in possession of fire-arms or anything capable of being used as a weapon of offence.
