- 7. Unfair Means Case will be registered against the candidate who is found in possession of fire-arms or anything capable of being used as a weapon of offence in or around Examination Hall.
- 8. No one is allowed to leave the Examination Hall before first one hour is over. If anyone leaves after one hour or before half the time is over, he/she shall not be allowed to take away the Question Paper.
- 9. Un-authorized change of Center is strictly prohibited. If anyone changes his/ her Center of Examination on his/ her own, Un-fair Means Case will be registered against him/her. Similarly, no change of subject is allowed unless permitted by the University.
- 10. No one can appear in the Examination without getting his/her Roll Number Slip. Unfair Means Case will be registered against those who violate the instructions and rules/regulations of the University.
- 11. The candidates are not allowed to bring/use mini-computer/calculator and mobile telephone sets in the Examination Hall. Unfair Means Case shall be registered against those who violate the above or such other instructions as are issued.

12. The candidates must reach examination center at 1:30 pm. No candidate will be allowed to enter examination hall after 2:00
