SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES

Candidates are directed to note the following instructions:-

- 1. Roll No. should be written on the right-side of the title page of the Answer Book only and not at any other place. Answer Book number should not be mentioned inside the Book.
- 2. Marks of identification should not be made any-where in the Answer Book or on the title page.
- 3. Part with any material relevant to the syllabus before entering into the Examination Hall.
- 4. No appeal to be made to the Examiner in the Answer Book and abusive or Obscene language should not be used in the answer book.
- 5.
